



**St. Ambrose** - One of the most illustrious Fathers and Doctors of the Church, born in 340 and consecrated Bishop of Milan in 374. He is remembered for the powerful role he played in the life of St. Augustine who was so moved by his preaching, and sought catechesis and baptism from him.

**St. Pier Giorgio Frassati** - Patron for youth, was born in Turin in 1901 into a prominent family. He was affectionately called the "Man of the Beatitudes" by Pope St. John Paul II for his exemplary work of bringing comfort and happiness to those who were poor, suffering, meek, hungry and in need of mercy. He died from polio at the age of 24 which he likely contracted while serving the sick in the slums of Turin. He was canonized on September 7, 2025 together with Carlo Acutis.



**St. Don Bosco** - Born in Turin in 1815, he is known as the Father and Teacher of Youth as he dedicated his life to educating and providing vocational training to poor and disadvantaged youth. He believed that Christ's love and our faith in that love should pervade everything we do - work, study, play. It is searching and finding God and Jesus in everything we do, letting their love lead us.

**St. Catherine of Siena** - She started having mystical experiences when she was only six. She became a Dominican tertiary when she was 16, and continued to have visions of Christ, Mary and the saints. She was one of the most brilliant theological minds of her day although she never had any formal education. Through her, thousands of people returned to the faith. She persuaded Pope Gregory XI to return the Papacy to Rome. St. Catherine's head is preserved in the Basilica of San Domenico in Siena.



**St. Bonaventure** - Doctor of the Church, born in Bagnoregio in 1221, he played an important role in both the medieval Church and the history of the Franciscan order. A senior faculty member of the University of Paris, he captured the hearts of his students through his academic skills and insights. But more importantly, he captured their hearts through his Franciscan love for Jesus and the Church. So much so that St. Bonaventure was given the title "Seraphic Doctor".




**St. Francis of Assisi** - Born in Italy in 1181, he abandoned a life of luxury for a life devoted to Christianity after reportedly hearing the voice of God. While praying before an old Byzantine crucifix at the Church of San Damiano, he heard the voice of Christ who told him to rebuild the Christian Church and to live a life of extreme poverty. He obeyed and devoted himself to Christianity. In 1224, St Francis reportedly received a vision that left him with the stigmata of Christ: the first person to receive such holy wounds.

**St. Clare of Assisi** - An Italian noblewoman who inspired by St. Francis, founded the Order of Poor Ladies, a contemplative monastic community for women. Known for her devotion to poverty, contemplation and the Eucharist, she wrote the first monastic rule for women.



**St. Carlo Acutis** - Canonized on September 7, 2025 he is the first Millennial Saint. He passed away in 2006 at just 15 years of age but he left an incredible legacy of holiness inspiring millions worldwide. Pope Francis called him "a model of holiness for the digital age". Carlo had an amazing love for God from a young age. He went to Mass and received Holy Communion daily. Carlo had an incredible devotion to the Eucharist and he created a website with all the known Eucharistic miracles to share with the world. He was diagnosed with terminal leukemia at age 15. Throughout his suffering he said: "I offer all for the Lord, the Pope, and the Church." We will venerate his entombed body in Assisi.

**St. Dominic** - The Founder of the Dominican Order, he is traditionally credited with spreading and popularizing the Rosary. Known for miracles and spiritual visitations in his lifetime, it is said that Dominic was visited by the Blessed Virgin in 1208 where she gave him the rosary which became the heart of the Dominican Order's prayerful life.



**St. Mark the Evangelist** - The author of the second Gospel, the oldest and the shortest of the four Gospels. The Gospel of Mark emphasizes Jesus' rejection by humanity while being God's triumphant envoy. His cousin was St. Barnabas and his father's cousin was St Peter.

**St. Anthony of Padua** - Patron saint of lost and stolen articles, was a powerful Franciscan preacher and teacher. Born in 1195 in Lisbon, Portugal, he entered the religious order of St. Augustine at the age of 15. He was a simple and holy friar who preached the Good News lovingly and with fearless courage. He made his headquarters in the city of Padua. He was named Doctor of the church in 1946.

## ITINERARY: DAY 1-5

### DAY 1 – TUESDAY, APRIL 21

Departure from Los Angeles (LAX) on an overnight flight to Rome, Italy.

### DAY 2 – WEDNESDAY, APRIL 22 – ARRIVAL IN ROME

- Arrival in Rome. Meet with the tour escort. Transfer to the hotel. Holy Mass at a local parish. Welcome dinner. Overnight.

### DAY 3 – THURSDAY, APRIL 23 – CIVITA DI BAGNOREGIO → ORVIETO → FLORENCE

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Departure for Civita di Bagnoregio, known as “the dying city” due to its location on a fragile volcanic tuff outcrop. Walking tour of the historic center, crossing its panoramic bridge and enjoying its medieval alleyways and views of the surrounding valley.
- Continuation to Orvieto. Visit to Orvieto Cathedral, a majestic example of Italian Gothic architecture, where the Holy Corporal of Bolsena is preserved. This relic comes from the Eucharistic Miracle of 1263, when a consecrated Host began to bleed during Holy Mass in the nearby town of Bolsena. Pope Urban IV transferred the corporal to Orvieto and ordered the construction of the Chapel of the Corporal, giving rise to the Feast of Corpus Christi. Holy Mass inside the Cathedral.
- Continuation with a visit to St. Patrick’s Well, a 16th-century engineering masterpiece, 62 meters deep, with independent helical ramps—one of the most outstanding examples of Renaissance hydraulic architecture.
- Free time for lunch on your own.
- Departure for Florence. Dinner at the hotel. Free evening walk in Florence. Overnight stay.

### DAY 4 – FRIDAY, APRIL 24 – FLORENCE → LOPPIANO → MILAN

- Breakfast at the hotel. Visit to the Loppiano Citadel, the first center of the Focolare Movement. Visit the Maria Theotokos Church and several community and formation spaces, where you can discover the international coexistence, spiritual life, and cultural and educational initiatives that take place within the citadel. Holy Mass.
- Free time for lunch on your own.
- Continuation to Milan. Dinner at the hotel. Free walking in the city center of Milan. Overnight stay.

### DAY 5 – SATURDAY, APRIL 25 – MILAN → TURIN → MILAN

- Breakfast at the hotel. Departure for Turin. Visit to the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, where the Holy Shroud is kept.
- Prayer at the tomb of St. Pier Giorgio Frassati, canonized by Pope Leo together with St. Carlo Acutis in September 2025. Frassati was found incorrupt when his coffin was opened during his beatification in 1981. Holy Mass. Free time for lunch on your own.
- Visit to the Basilica of Our Lady Help of Christians, headquarters of the Salesian congregation founded by St. John Bosco. The basilica is dedicated to Marian devotion to Mary Help of Christians and serves as a spiritual reference point for the educational and pastoral mission of the Salesians.
- Return to the hotel in Milan. Dinner at the hotel. Free evening walk in the city center of Milan.

## ITINERARY: DAY 6-9

### DAY 6 – SUNDAY, APRIL 26 – MILAN → PADUA

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Departure for a visit to Milan Cathedral (Duomo) and Piazza del Duomo. Walking tour through the monumental heart of the city, dominated by the impressive Milan Cathedral, one of the masterpieces of European Gothic architecture and the largest church in Italy after St. Peter's Basilica. During the visit, you will admire its extraordinary white marble façade, spires, and sculptures, as well as its luminous interior, which houses important works of art and sacred relics.
- The experience continues with a walk through Piazza del Duomo, the vibrant center of Milan. From here, you can appreciate the grandeur of the architectural complex and access some of the city's most iconic landmarks, such as the historic Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II. This is the ideal setting to understand the historical, religious, and cultural significance of the Duomo in the life of Milan. Holy Mass.
- Free time for lunch on your own.
- Departure for Padua. Dinner at the hotel. Free evening walk in the city center of Padua. Overnight stay.

### DAY 7 – MONDAY, APRIL 27 – PADUA → VENICE → PADUA

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Departure for the Basilica of St. Anthony, an important pilgrimage site. St. Anthony of Padua is buried in this basilica. His tongue, miraculously preserved, is displayed here as a symbol of his powerful preaching. Holy Mass.
- Transfer to Venice. Visit to Venice, beginning with St. Mark's Basilica, a jewel of Western Byzantine art, renowned for its golden mosaics and for housing the tomb of St. Mark the Evangelist.
- Continuation to the Doge's Palace, former seat of political power of the Republic of Venice, noted for its magnificent decoration and its famous connection to the Bridge of Sighs.
- Free time for lunch on your own and the option to enjoy an optional gondola ride.
- Return to the hotel in Padua. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay.

### DAY 8 – TUESDAY, APRIL 28 – PADUA → SAN MARINO → ASSISI

- Departure for San Marino.
- Visit to San Marino, a small microstate nestled within Italy and one of the oldest republics in the world, founded in 301 AD. It is renowned for its medieval historic center and for the spectacular panoramic views from Mount Taitano.
- Free time for lunch on your own.
- Departure for Assisi, the city of St. Francis and St. Clare. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay.

### DAY 9 – WEDNESDAY, APRIL 29 – ASSISI

- Breakfast at the hotel. Visit to the Basilica of St. Francis, where he is buried directly beneath the main altar of the Lower Church. Visit to the Basilica of St. Clare, where her body was laid beneath the main altar in October 1260. In the Chapel of St. George, view the San Damiano Cross, from which Jesus spoke to St. Francis, asking him to rebuild the Church. Visit to the Sanctuary of the Spoliation, where you may pray before the body of St. Carlo Acutis, the first saint of the new millennium. Holy Mass. Free time for lunch on your own. Visit the Church of San Damiano, the place where St. Francis heard the call of Jesus. Visit to the Porziuncola, the historic chapel used by St. Francis as his spiritual home. Transfer to the hotel. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay.

## ITINERARY: DAY 10-12

### DAY 10 – THURSDAY, APRIL 30 – ASSISI → ROME

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Departure for Rome.
- Visit to St. Peter's Basilica and Dome in Vatican City, the heart of Christianity and one of the masterpieces of Renaissance art and architecture. Guided walk through the interior of the Basilica, with time to admire Michelangelo's Pietà, Bernini's Baldachin, and the papal altars. Optional ascent to the Dome, offering exceptional panoramic views of Vatican City and Rome.
- Holy Mass at the Church of Divine Mercy, Santa Maria in Sassia, a shrine dedicated to devotion to the Divine Mercy and an important place for prayer and reflection.
- Free time for lunch on your own.
- Free afternoon in Rome.
- Suggested walking route: Piazza Navona, Campo de' Fiori, the Synagogue area, the Mouth of Truth (Bocca della Verità), Circus Maximus, and the Colosseum (exterior).
- Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay.

### DAY 11 – FRIDAY, MAY 1 – ROME → CASTEL GANDOLFO → NEMI

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Guided visit to one of the most important Christian catacombs in Rome, burial place of numerous martyrs and several Popes from the early centuries of Christianity. Walk through the underground galleries with an explanation of their historical and spiritual significance.
- Transfer to Castel Gandolfo.
- Visit to Castel Gandolfo, a picturesque town on the shores of Lake Albano, historically recognized as the summer residence of the Holy Father. Walk through the historic center and time to enjoy the panoramic views.
- Free time for lunch on your own.
- Transfer to and visit of Nemi, a charming town in the Lazio region, located on the rim of an ancient volcanic crater, offering beautiful views of Lake Nemi. The town is known for its historic charm, peaceful atmosphere, and the Church of the Crucifix, a place of devotion and spiritual reflection. Holy Mass at the Church of the Crucifix.
- Free time for lunch on your own.
- Farewell dinner in Nemi at a local restaurant (organized by Fr. Santi). Transfer to the hotel in Rome. Overnight stay.

### DAY 12 – SATURDAY, MAY 2 – ROME → LOS ANGELES

- Transfer to Fiumicino Airport. Check-in and boarding procedures for the return flight to Los Angeles.
- End of the pilgrimage.



## ITINERARIO – DÍAS 1 AL 5

### DÍA 1 – MARTES 21 DE ABRIL      LOS ÁNGELES → ROMA

Salida desde Los Ángeles (LAX), vuelo nocturno a Roma, Italia

### DÍA 2 – MIÉRCOLES 22 DE ABRIL      LLEGADA A ROMA

- Llegada A Roma. Encuentro con nuestro guía acompañante.
- Traslado al hotel. Santa Misa en una parroquia local. Cena de bienvenida. Alojamiento.

### DÍA 3 – JUEVES 23 DE ABRIL      CIVITA DI BAGNOREGIO → ORVIETO → FLORENCIA

- Desayuno en el hotel.
- Salida hacia Civita di Bagnoregio, conocida como “la ciudad que muere” por su ubicación sobre un frágil espolón de toba volcánica. Paseo por el casco histórico, cruzando su puente panorámico y disfrutando de sus callejuelas medievales y vistas del valle.
- Continuación a Orvieto. Visita de la Catedral de Orvieto, majestuoso ejemplo del gótico italiano, donde se conserva el Santo Corporal de Bolsena, reliquia del milagro eucarístico de 1.263, cuando una hostia consagrada comenzó a sangrar durante la Santa Misa en la vecina localidad de Bolsena. El papa Urbano IV trasladó el corporal a Orvieto y mandó construir la Capilla del Corporal, dando origen a la fiesta del Corpus Christi. Santa Misa dentro de la catedral. Continuación con la visita del Pozo de San Patricio, obra de ingeniería del siglo XVI, con sus 62 metros de profundidad y sus rampas helicoidales independientes, uno de los ejemplos más destacados de la arquitectura hidráulica renacentista.
- Tiempo libre para el almuerzo por cuenta propia.
- Salida hacia Florencia. Cena en el hotel. Paseo libre Por Florencia. Alojamiento.

### DÍA 4 – VIERNES 24 DE ABRIL      FLORENCIA → LOPPIANO → MILÁN

- Desayuno en el hotel. Visita de la Ciudadela de Loppiano, primera sede del Movimiento de los Focolares. Visita de la Iglesia María Theotokos y de algunos espacios comunitarios y formativos, descubriendo la convivencia internacional, la vida espiritual y las iniciativas culturales y educativas que se desarrollan en la ciudadela. Santa Misa.
- Tiempo libre para el almuerzo por cuenta propia.
- Continuación a Milán. Cena en el hotel. Paseo libre por el centro de Milán. Alojamiento.

### DÍA 5 – SÁBADO 25 DE ABRIL      MILÁN → TURÍN → MILÁN

- Desayuno en el hotel.
- Salida hacia Turín. Visita a la catedral de San Juan Bautista (donde se encuentra la Sábana Santa).
- Oración ante la tumba de San Pier Giorgio Frassati, canonizado por el papa León junto con San Carlo Acutis en septiembre de 2025. Frassati se encontró incorrupto cuando se abrió su ataúd durante su beatificación en 1981. Santa Misa Tiempo libre para el almuerzo por cuenta propia.
- Visita a la Basílica de Nuestra Señora Auxiliadora, sede de la congregación salesiana fundada por San Juan Bosco, dedicada a la devoción mariana de María Auxiliadora y referente espiritual de la labor educativa y pastoral de los salesianos. Regreso al hotel en Milán. Cena en el hotel. Paseo libre por el centro de Milán.

## ITINERARIO – DÍAS 6 AL 9

### DÍA 6 – DOMINGO 26 DE ABRIL MILÁN → PADUA

- Desayuno en el hotel. Salida y visita a la Catedral y la Piazza del Duomo de Milán.
- Recorrido por el corazón monumental de la ciudad, donde se alza la imponente Catedral de Milán, una de las obras maestras del gótico europeo y el templo más grande de Italia tras San Pedro. Durante la visita se podrán contemplar su extraordinaria fachada de mármol blanco, sus pináculos y esculturas, así como su luminoso interior, que alberga importantes obras de arte y reliquias.
- La experiencia se completa con un paseo por la Piazza del Duomo, centro neurálgico de Milán. Desde aquí se aprecia la grandiosidad del conjunto arquitectónico y se accede a algunos de los lugares más emblemáticos de la ciudad, como la histórica Galería Vittorio Emanuele II. Es el punto ideal para comprender la relevancia histórica, religiosa y cultural del Duomo en la vida milanesa.
- Santa Misa. Tiempo libre para el almuerzo por cuenta propia.
- Salida hacia Padua. Cena en el hotel. Paseo libre por el centro de Padua. Alojamiento.

### DÍA 7 – LUNES 27 DE ABRIL PADUA → VENECIA → PADUA

- Desayuno en el hotel. Salida hacia la Basílica de San Antonio, un importante lugar de peregrinación. San Antonio de Padua está enterrado en esta basílica. Su lengua, milagrosamente incorrupta, se exhibe aquí, como símbolo de su poderosa predicación. Santa Misa.
- Traslado a Venecia. Visita de Venecia, comenzando por la Basílica de San Marcos, joya del arte bizantino occidental, famosa por sus mosaicos dorados y por albergar la tumba del Evangelista San Marcos.
